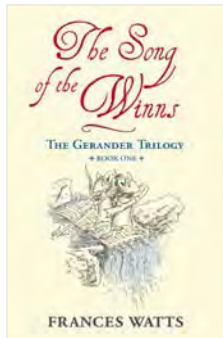
Lara is new in town and resents it – Kahu is a talented carver, outwardly cocky and confident but riddled with doubts and fears.

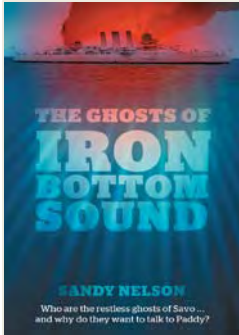

- The Guadalcanal Campaign exemplifies the heroism of the Allied forces (US, Australia and New Zealand) over the Japanese in the Pacific theatre
- The U.S. Navy suffered such high personnel losses during the campaign that it refused to publicly release total casualty figures for years.
