TELEGRAPH AVENUE

As the summer of 2004 draws to a close, Archy Stallings and Nat Jaffe are longtime friends and co-owners of Brokeland Records, a kingdom of used vinyl. Their wives, Gwen and Aviva, are the Berkeley Birth Partners, a pair of semi-legendary nurse midwives. Archy and Gwen are expecting their first baby; Nat and Aviva have a teenaged son. Cranky, flawed, and loving each other, they have worked to construct lives that reach across barriers of race and class. When ex-NFL quarterback Gibson Goode, the fourth-richest black man in America, announces plans to go forward with the construction of his latest megastore, Nat and Archy fear it means certain doom for their vulnerable little enterprise. What they don't know is that Goode's announcement marks the climax of a decades-old secret history, encompassing a forgotten crime of the Black Panther era and the failure of American optimism about race. Generous, imaginative, funny, moving, thrilling, humane, triumphant, *Telegraph Avenue* is Michael Chabon's most dazzling book yet.

FLIGHT BEHAVIOR

The *New York Times* bestselling author of *The Lacuna* and *The Poisonwood Bible* returns with a book set in rural Appalachia. Dellarobia Turnbow is a twenty-nine-year-old who nurtured worldly ambitions before becoming a mother and wife at seventeen. Now, after more than a decade of tending small children on a failing farm, she mitigates her boredom in a flirtation with a younger man. Headed to his secluded mountain cabin, she finds a forested valley filled with silent red fire that appears to be a miracle. Her discovery elicits divergent reactions from all sides: fundamentalists claim it as a sign from God; climate scientists see it as an element of forthcoming disaster; politicians declaim its lessons; charlatans mine its opportunity; international media fan the story; and townspeople cope with the intrusion. The Queen decides to visit the scene of so many happy memories, Her Majesty's former royal yacht, *Britannia*, now moored in Leith, Scotland. All she has to do is get to Kings Cross Station and hop on a train from there. Meanwhile, an unlikely group of six courtiers are the only ones who know of the Queen's disappearance, and they vow to find her and bring her back to the palace before MI6 turn her desertion into a major national scandal. A lively, witty debut novel that makes light of the rigidity and pomp and circumstance of the British monarchy, but that also breathes humanity into it, and into its central figure, Queen Elizabeth.

Bacharach, Burt

ANYONE WHO HAD A HEART

Told in Burt Bacharach's own words, *Anyone Who Had a Heart* is the story of one of the greatest songwriters of all time. Over the course of his career, Bacharach has had seventy Top 40 hits, won three Academy Awards, eight Grammys, an Emmy, and been nominated for a Tony Award. Raised in Forest Hills, New York, Bacharach fell in love with music after sneaking into a Manhattan club to see Dizzy Gillespie play. A string of early successes in the late fifties led to his famous collaborations with Dionne Warwick, and the beginning of a lauded career scoring films. While he has written countless songs about the search for love and the heartbreak that comes when it is lost, Bacharach's first three marriages ended in divorce and his daughter Nikki committed suicide at the age of forty. His long-running writing partnership with Hal David fell apart and the two did not speak for seventeen years. As powerful and moving as his most unforgettable songs, *Anyone Who Had a Heart* provides readers with a backstage pass to the world of show business, and a look at the life of an artist whose incredible body of work has earned him a unique position in the American cultural landscape.

ZUMWALT

In December 1970 Admiral Elmo Russell Zumwalt landed on the cover of *Time* magazine, which called the charismatic Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) "the Navy's most popular leader since WWII." What set Zumwalt apart was his ability to enact radical change, a quality best exemplified by his success in integrating the most racist branch of the military. Zumwalt's tenure as CNO (1970-1974) came at a time marked by a strong Soviet challenge to U.S. naval supremacy, a duplicitous end-game in Vietnam, the Watergate scandal and an Admirals' spy ring. Zumwalt retired from the Navy in 1974. Anguished by the unwitting role he played in his own son's death from exposure to Agent Orange, Zumwalt's final battle was for Vietnam veterans and their children, spearheading a successful class action suit against the manufacturers of Agent Orange, earning him our nation's highest civilian honor, the Presidential Medal of Freedom. TITIAN

Titian is, with Michelangelo and Raphael, one of the three towering giants of High Renaissance painting, and one of the greatest and most influential of all European artists. He was Venice's greatest artist, and contributed to its Golden Age in the sixteenth century. He was notorious for disregarding authority and for his stubbornness. None of this, however, deterred his patrons, who included the Hapsburgs, Italian princes, the Pope, and Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor. During his career, which spanned more than seventy years, Titian painted some two hundred pictures of which less than half survive. His work has been studied by generations of great artists. Sheila Hale's magisterial biography, over ten years in the making, is sure to be hailed as a landmark biography of this challenging and fascinating artist. Operating out of a tiny Madison Avenue office in the early 1960s, a struggling company called Marvel Comics introduced a series of superhero characters that thrilled not just children but also pop artists, intellectuals, and campus radicals: The Fantastic Four. Spider-Man. The Hulk. The X-Men. Iron Man. Thor. Daredevil. Throughout the decades-long journey to a multi-billion-dollar enterprise, Marvel's identity has continually shifted from scrappy underdog to corporate behemoth. Over the years, its contributors struggled with commercial mandates, a fickle audience, and, over matters of credit and control, one another. AN EXTRAORDINARY THEORY OF OBJECTS

An Extraordinary Theory of Objects is the story of Stephanie LaCava, an awkward, curious girl who finds solace and security in strange and beautiful objects as she navigates growing up in a foreign country. Forced to move to a suburb of Paris, she feels adrift, subject to latent anxieties and soon falls into a deep depression. Yet, even in her darkest moments she never stopped filtering the world through her own peculiar lens, discovering the strange sorts of beauty which surrounded her. Ranging from the grotesque (beetles and catacombs), the natural (mushrooms and lilies of the valley) to the cultural (Nirvana and other nineties touchstones) and the historical (Nancy Cunard, Jean Seberg) - all of these objects and people became an outsider's talismans, allowing her to survive in a place where she feels she's lost control. THORNTON WILDER

Thornton Wilder was a pivotal figure in the twentieth century, both as a novelist and playwright, winning the Pulitzer Prize three times for both fiction and drama. He traveled constantly throughout his life, doing much of his best writing at resorts and in hotel rooms, and had a wide circle of friends in the theater, movies, and literature. *Thornton Wilder* is the first biography of the playwright and novelist to be based on thousands of pages of letters, journals, manuscripts, and other documentary evidence of Wilder's life, work, and times. In 1934, *Webster's Second* was the great gray eminence of American dictionaries, with 600,000 entries and numerous competitors but no rivals. It served as the all-knowing guide to the world of grammar and information. In 1961, *Webster's Third* came along and ignited an unprecedented controversy in America. The new dictionary's editor, Philip Gove, had determined that correct use was determined by how the language was actually spoken, and not by "notions of correctness" set by the learned few – a position viewed by many as "the end of civilization." Critical parties took particular umbrage at *Webster's Third's* treatment of "ain't." *The Story of Ain't* describes a great cultural shift in America, when the voice of the masses resounded in the highest halls of culture, when the division between highbrow and lowbrow was inalterably blurred.

SOLO

Hope Solo cares about winning medals, not friends, thriving on competition and unafraid to say it or show it. Driven to succeed on her own terms, she's never played it safe, even if it cost her a starting spot with the U.S. women's soccer team during the 2007 World Cup. That aggressive determination is encapsulated in her forthright, sometimes shocking, and ultimately moving memoir. At the center of her story is the sweet and sorrowful relationship with her father, a philanderer and a conman who was convicted of embezzlement. Drifting into homelessness after prison, he finally reconciled with his daughter when she was in college. Solo reveals how her father not only taught her the game, but also instilled in her the athlete's mentality that defines who she is and how she plays. A woman who has repeatedly triumphed over adversity - from suddenly losing her dad to her battles with the U.S. national team, to her recovery from painful shoulder surgery - her story holds lessons and insight not only for her thousands of fans, but for us all.

Nearly two hundred and fifty years ago, a group of American citizens decided that the conditions under which they were governed had become intolerable, and that no change would be forthcoming as a result of mere complaint and petition. Action would have to be taken. And because these actions were illegal, their undertakings and the identities of those who carried them out would be by necessity covert. The men who called themselves Sons of Liberty - Samuel Adams, John Adams, Paul Revere, Patrick Henry, and John Hancock among them - were patriots in the eyes of most Americans and remain so to this day. In the eyes of the British they were terrorists who deserved to pay with their lives for the things they had done. This is the story of how those forces metamorphosed from murmurings of a vague injustice to focused operations of resistance led by men whose names are now legend.

Raised by an abusive grandmother in West London, Townshend describes a frenetic childhood of displacement...until meeting Roger Daltrey in high school. Together, they form the first incarnation of a band that will travel the world and bring them into the inner sanctums of Eric Clapton's drug-ridden hotel rooms, and at the feet of Jimi Hendrix.
